

## Broward Girls' basketball: 5 teams to watch

### **Nova**

2006 record: 26-6

Titans' first-year coach Jason Hively is no newcomer - as an assistant coach with the Titans, he's worked with returning starters Jasmine Bradley and Jahkerria Harvey. The defending District 16-5A champs have the depth and speed for another championship run.

### **Dillard**

2006 record: 21-7

The Panthers have always been one of the county's strongest programs and with four returning starters, they can make another run at a state title. Led by Chelsea Regins, Danilsa Andujar and Dawnn Maye, the defending BCAA Big 8 champs will be worth watching.

### **Ely**

2006 record: 22-6

Three seasons ago, the Tigers were a county doormat, finishing 2-18. But last year, they were one of Broward's best, advancing to the state tournament. This year's players are young, but they have an experienced leader in Joanna Harden and can't be counted out.

### **Parkway Academy**

2006 record: 25-6

The Panthers made their first appearance at the state tournament last year and were two points short of winning the Class 3A title. They return a solid core of players including leading scorer Erica Williams. They also added a strong inside presence with Chelsey Lee.

### **South Broward**

2006 record: 21-8

Like Dillard, the Bulldogs are among the county's traditional powers. This year's team features five returning starters, including Angela Smith, Ruthie Martin and Christal Washington. That experience could help South Broward make a good postseason push.
